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DECEMBER 2012 VFACTS HIGHLIGHTS

RECORD FULL YEAR INDUSTRY – 1,112,032 UNITS

December month 2012, the Automotive Industry in Australia achieved total vehicle sales of 95,427 units, up 12,968 units or 15.7% on December month 2011. December 2012 retail sales volume represents the best December sales month on record, and, on a Seasonally Adjusted Annual Rate, the Automotive Industry for December 2012 came in at 1,151,000 units. The Vehicle Industry has now achieved a SAAR of in excess of 1,000,000 units in each of the past 16 months, with the last eight months each achieving record volume for the Vehicle Industry. All industry segments achieved year over year volume growth in December with the Heavy Truck Segment achieving least growth at just 7.8%. The Light Commercial Segment achieved greatest year over year growth for December, up 40.3%.

The SUV and Light Commercial Industry Segments both achieved full year record sales volumes.

Continuing to drive industry sales volumes were the manufacturers “finance offer” marketing incentives in the market and year end clearance sales as manufacturers strived to achieve full year sales volume and market share targets.

These manufacturer “finance offer” promotions have continued into 2013 and we also see 2012 “plated” vehicle sales being heavily advertised. These activities should ensure that vehicle sales remain strong for the immediate future. In addition, Japanese manufacturers financial year ends in March, therefore, we will see aggressive marketing activity continue into the first quarter of 2013.


Full year 2012, total industry sales of 1,112,032 was achieved, up 103,595 units or 10.3% on 2011 full year sales. In total, 24 manufacturers in the Australian Automotive Industry achieved new full year sales record volumes in 2012. Record sales volume was achieved by the following manufacturers:

Autoteam forecast for full year 2013 sales volume is 1,075,000 units, down 37,032 units or 3.3% on 2012 sales volume.



The Passenger Industry continues to lose industry share and for 2012 accounted for just 51.9% of the total vehicle industry, compared to 60.7% just five years back in 2007.

Industry Highlights

- Among the top 30 brands in the market place for 2012, only Holden, Ford, Mitsubishi, Peugeot, Mitsubishi Fuso and Dodge are down in sales volume year over year, while Toyota, VW, KIA, Jeep (up 108.3%), Great Wall, Land Rover, Isuzu Ute, Renault, Hino and Kenworth all achieved year over year volume growth of in excess of 20%, although several off a low volume base. The top ten nameplates in the Australian Automotive Industry account for 80% of all vehicles sold (67 manufacturers in total).
- All Industry segments achieved year over year growth for December and for full year 2012. Full year 2012, the SUV Industry was up 61,689 units or 25.3%, while the Light Commercial Industry was up 21,576 units or 12.2%.
- Among the Passenger Industry, only the Large Segment incurred full year volume loss for 2012 compared to 2011. The Large Segment was down 14,981 units or 19.2% (Commodore and Falcon combined were down 14,790 units). The Medium Segment achieved full year volume growth of 11,690 units (Camry 8,061 units), while the Sports Segment was up 6,867 units or 47.1% (new models Veloster up 4,107 units and Toyota 86 up 2047 units).
- Full year 2012, the Small Segment of the SUV Industry was up 21,148 units (Compass/Patriot up 4,146 units, Dualis up 3,927 units and Subaru XV up 9,908 units). The Medium Segment of the SUV Industry was up 19,829 units (Mazda CX-5 up 15,861 units and X-Trail up 3,977 units. The Large Segment of the SUV Industry

was up 19,071 units with most models achieving volume growth but Prado, up 6,196 units, up the most.

- The PU/CC 4X4 Segment achieved full year volume growth of 24,686 units or 24.7% with most models up year on year, but BT-50 up 3,756 units, Navara up 3,778 units, Hilux up 5,542 and Amarok up 3,661 units, up the most.
- Among the states and territories for full year 2012, all achieved year over year volume growth. Western Australia and Northern Territory, up 16.9% and 16.1% respectively achieved greatest year over year growth. By comparison, Tasmania achieved full year growth of just 1.3% or 212 units. In terms of volume, NSW, Victoria and Queensland all achieved volume growth of in excess of 20,000 for the full year. These three states account for 78.3% of national sales.
- By buyer type, only Government sales were down for full year 2012 compared to 2011. Private vehicle sales accounted for 48.6% of all vehicle sales full year 2012.
- By fuel type, petrol vehicle sales continue to lose industry share and while they achieved year over year growth, it was less than achieved for the industry in total. Full year 2012, Hybrid (59.8%) and LPG (87.1%) sales were up most year over year, although both coming off a small volume base. Diesel vehicle sales (predominantly SUV and Light Commercial vehicles) were up 63,753 units or 21.6% full year 2012 and accounted for 32.2% of all vehicles sold, compared to 29.2% for 2011.
- Locally manufactured vehicle industry share for 2012 accounted for just 12.6% of the total industry volume. Toyota was the only local manufacturer to increase sales volume of locally manufactured vehicles, a reflection of the successful Camry sales results over recent months. Vehicles sourced out of Japan, Thailand and Korea now account for more sales than locally manufactured vehicles. This trend will continue into the future as local production volumes continue to come down.
- Toyota maintained market leadership for the Total, Passenger, SUV and Light Commercial Industries for December and full year 2012. Full year 2012, Toyota achieved sales of 218,176 units for an industry market share of 20.1%. Holden was second with sales of 114,665 units, ahead of Holden 114,665 units, Mazda 103,886 units, Hyundai 91,536 units, Ford 90,408 units and Nissan 79,747 units.
- Mazda 3 maintained the position of top selling model in the market with full year sales of 44,128 units, ahead of Hilux 40,646 units and Corolla 38,799 units.
